

Admission to study in specialty programs in 2023/24 academic year

Places funded from the federal budget

Target quota - places for admission to training of persons who have concluded contracts with customer organizations. The number of places, the list of customers of target places are determined annually by the founder of the university (Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation).

Please note: the customers of targeted training do not finance the training of students. The training of state employees is funded by the founding organization, i.e. the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation.

A special quota is at least 10% of budget places. The following can apply for special quota places:

- orphans and children left without parental care;
- orphans and children left without parental care until the age of 23;
- children with disabilities, disabled people of groups I and II, disabled since childhood;
- invalids as a result of a military injury or disease received during military service;
- combat veterans.

A separate quota is at least 10% of budget places. In accordance with Part 5.1 of Article 71 of Federal Law No. 273-FL, the following have the right to be admitted to places within a separate quota: 1) Heroes of the Russian Federation, persons awarded three Orders of Courage; 2) children of persons who took part in a special military operation in the territories of Ukraine, the Donetsk People's Republic, Luhansk People's Republic, Zaporozhye region and Kherson region (hereinafter - persons who took part in a special military operation):

- military personnel (including those who served in the period of mobilization, martial law or under a contract concluded in accordance with paragraph 7 of Article 38 of the Federal Law of March 28, 1998 No. 53-FL "On military duty and military service");

Separate quota:

- persons who have entered into a contract on voluntary assistance in the performance of tasks assigned to the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation;

3) children of military personnel, employees of federal executive bodies and federal state bodies in which military service is provided for by federal law, employees of internal affairs bodies of the Russian Federation sent to other states by state authorities of the Russian Federation and who took part in hostilities in the performance of official duties in these states (hereinafter - military personnel, employees sent to other states).

- employees of federal executive bodies and federal state bodies in which military service is provided for by federal law, employees of internal affairs bodies of the Russian Federation, employees of the penitentiary system of the Russian Federation;

- Target quota - places for admission to training of persons, entered into agreements with customer organizations. The number of places, the list of customers of target places are annually determined by the founder of the university (Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation).
- The main places within the target figures are budgetary places left vacant after the allocation of quotas, places for the general competition.
- Special quota - at least 10% of budget places.
- Separate quota - at least 10% of budget places.

At the Dagestan State Medical University, an applicant may participate in the competition at the same time for no more than 3 specialties.

Competitive groups (within each specialty): 1) places within the target quota 2) places within a special quota 3) places within a separate quota 4) budget places remaining vacant after enrollment according to quotas (general competition) 5) places under contracts on the provision of paid educational services for citizens of Russia 6) places under agreements on the provision of paid educational services for foreign citizens and stateless persons.

A citizen of Russia can apply for admission and participate in the competition simultaneously in five of the listed competition groups (clauses 1-5). And that's just one of the three specialties.

Admission conditions

- Specialty
- Budget or non-budget places
- Within budget places:
 - target quota
 - special quota
 - separate quota main places within target figures

List of entrance tests:

- Chemistry;
- Biology;
- Russian language.

Priority of entrance examinations when ranking applicants by points:

1. Chemistry;
2. Biology;
3. Russian language.

Categories who can take entrance examinations at the university

- 1) disabled people (including disabled children);
- 2) foreign citizens;
- 3) in those subjects in which the applicant did not pass the USE in the current year, if the applicant received a document on secondary general education in a foreign organization;
- 4) applicants on the basis of secondary vocational or higher education;
- 5) applicants for places within a separate quota (list No. 2).

Entrance examinations conducted by the university independently

- Entrance examinations at the university are held in writing in person. Applicant submits each of the entrance examinations tests only once. Retake of the entrance test is not allowed.
- The schedule of entrance examinations is posted on the website of the University no later than June 1.
- Persons who did not pass the entrance test at the set time for a good reason (illness or other documented reasons) are allowed to pass the entrance test on the reserve day.
- Persons who have not passed the entrance test in the established time without a valid reason (those who did not appear at the entrance examination), are not allowed to the subsequent entrance examinations and are considered to have dropped out of the competition.

If the applicant passes the entrance examinations at the university

For applicants on the basis of secondary general education:

- chemistry;
- biology;
- Russian language.

For applicants on the basis of secondary vocational and higher education:

- medical chemistry;
- medical biology;
- Russian language.

School Olympiads

Winners and prize-winners of the final stage of the All-Russian Olympiad for schoolchildren, members of the national teams of the Russian Federation participating in international Olympiads in general education subjects (...) are given an advantage by equating to persons with 100 points in the general education entrance test.

Winners and prize-winners of Olympiads for schoolchildren of levels I and II, held in the order (...), are given an advantage by equating to persons with 100 points in the general education entrance test.

To obtain the right to 100 points, the winners and prize-winners of the Olympiads must score at least 75 USE points in the relevant subject

Citizens of the Republic of Belarus

- Citizens of the Republic of Belarus have the right to use the results of the centralized testing conducted in the Republic of Belarus, passed by applicants in the current or previous calendar year. The results of centralized testing are recognized by the university as the results of general education entrance examinations, if the applicant did not pass the USE in the corresponding general education subject in the year when the certificate of centralized testing was received.
- The results of centralized testing are presented not later than the dead-line of documents acceptance.

Features of the reception of foreign citizens and stateless persons

The university has established the following list of entrance examinations for foreign citizens and stateless persons when enrolling in specialist programs under contracts for the provision of paid educational services:

- Chemistry
- Biology

The University holds a separate competition for places under contracts for the provision of paid educational services allocated for the admission of foreign citizens and stateless persons.

Individual achievements of the applicant

For documents on education or on education and qualifications with honors obtained in educational organizations of the Russian Federation (certificate of secondary general education with honors, diploma of secondary vocational education with honors, diploma of primary vocational education with honors) - 3 points are granted.

Individual achievements of the applicant

Golden, silver or bronze insignia of the All-Russian physical culture and sports complex "Ready for Labor and Defense" (RLD) – 2 points granted.

The accrual of points for the the RLD sign is carried out once.

Individual achievements of the applicant

Points awarded for individual achievements are added to competitive points.

If an applicant submits several documents on education to consider individual achievements, points are awarded for only one of the specified documents.

The passing score is the minimum amount of points with which applicants were enrolled for training. In the list ranked by points (distributed from the maximum amount to the minimum) the list of incoming applicants will be considered as passing the sum of the points of the last enrolled.

The passing score becomes known only after enrollment, i.e. it is not defined or predetermined and not predetermined.

An applicant for undergraduate and specialist degree programs has the right to apply for admission at the same time to no more than 5 higher education institutions.

Information about submitted applications, entrance examination scores, enrollment orders entered in If an applicant applies for admission to more than 5 educational organizations, FIS GIA and admission is not to no organization FIS GIA and reception will allow it to be counted.

List of documents

- Application for admission
 - Document of education (original or copy)
 - Copy of passport
 - Copy of compulsory pension insurance certificate (citizens of Russia)
 - Medical certificate (information on the website dgm.ru)
 - Document confirming special rights, disability (if available)
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- Other documents (at the discretion of the entrant)
 - Agreement between the entrant and the customer organization (for entrants to the places of the target quota)
 - A document confirming the right to admission to within a separate quota (for applicants to places within a separate quota)
 - Photo size 3x4 cm - for passing entrance examinations based on university materials

Acceptance of documents

- When submitting documents, applicants may submit originals or copies (electronic samples) of documents without submitting their originals. Certification of these copies (electronic samples) is not required.
- When applying for admission through EPGU, a document on education is considered to be submitted in a copy if information about it is confirmed in the federal information system "Federal Register of Information on Documents on Education and (or) Qualifications, Documents on Training" (FRDO).
- Other documents are considered to be submitted in copies if the information about them is confirmed by the information available in the EPGU or in other state information systems.

Deadlines for receiving documents

- Beginning of acceptance of documents - June 20
- Completion of acceptance of documents - July 25
- Completion of acceptance of documents from persons entering the results of entrance examinations conducted by the university independently - July 10

Ranked lists of applicants

- Competitive lists are formed from the number of persons who scored on the general education entrance examinations the number of points not lower than the minimum, confirming the successful completion of these tests.
- Competitive lists of applicants are ranked (distributed in descending order) in accordance with the amount of competitive points, compiled for each competitive group separately - by specialty, for places within quotas, for budget places according to the general competition, for places under contracts for the provision of paid educational services.
- Competitive lists are published on the official website university.

Ranked lists of applicants

In the competitive list (with the exception of the list of applicants for places within a separate quota) the following information is indicated:

- 1) SNILS (Insurance Number of Personal Account) or a unique code assigned to the applicant (in the absence of SNILS);
 - 2) for each applicant based on the results of entrance examinations:
 - 3) the presence of the original document on education (or a mark on the submission to the university of the original document on education, put up by applicants for EPGU (Unified Portal of State Services);
 - 4) the presence of a statement of consent to enrollment (when admitted to study under contracts for the provision of paid educational services in case of failure to submit the original document of education to the university and the absence of a mark on the submission of the original to the university, put up by applicants for EPGU);
 - 5) enrollment priority.
 - the amount of competitive points (for entrance examinations and individual achievements);
 - sum of points for entrance examinations;
 - the number of points for each entrance test;
 - number of points for individual achievements;
 - Preferential enrollment rights;
- In the competitive list, the surname, name, patronymic of applicants are not indicated!

Enrollment

- For enrollment, an applicant submits an original document of education or puts a mark on the submission of the original to the EPGU.
- Enrollment is carried out in accordance with the enrollment priorities specified in the application (applications) for admission, according to the competitive lists until the prescribed number of places.
- Applicants to places within the control digits are enrolled in accordance with the highest priority of enrollment, according to which he passes through the competition for the specified places.

Enrollment

July 27 - publication of competitive lists on the university website.

July 28 at 12:00 Moscow time – deadline for accepting original document on education from persons entering the places within the quotas.

July 30 - issuance of orders for admission to places in within quotas.

August 3 at 12:00 Moscow time - deadline for accepting original documents on education from applicants for state-funded places that remain vacant after enrolling in places within quotas (general competition).

August 5 - issuance of an order on enrollment in budget places remaining vacant after enrollment in places within quotas (general competition).

Enrollment

- At each stage of enrollment, the university determines the highest enrollment priority for which the applicant passes through the competition (highest priority).

- In the event that an applicant enrolled at the stage of priority admission (to places within quotas) wants to participate in the competition and be enrolled in budget places according to the general competition, he/she applies for refusal of enrollment carried out to places within quotas.

Places that have become vacant due to the fact that persons enrolled at the stage of priority enrollment (places within quotas) are excluded from enrollment are added to the main competitive places.

Admission to places under contracts for the provision of paid educational services

July 27 - publication of competitive lists on the university website.

August 7 - the conclusion of contracts for the provision of paid educational services is completed.

August 8 – publication of lists of persons recommended for enrollment who have concluded an agreement on the provision of paid educational services, subject to the following conditions:

- 1) information about a standard document is confirmed by information from the FRDO or the University;
- 2) the University has a certified copy of the standard document submitted by the applicant (a copy certified by the University on the basis of the original submitted by the applicant).

Admission to places under contracts for the provision of paid educational services

August 15 - order on enrollment in places under contracts for the provision of paid educational services is signed. Only persons recommended for enrollment are enrolled, those whose payment for the first year of study was made before August 14, 2023.
