Special aspects in admission of foreign citizens, stateless persons

Foreign citizens and stateless persons are entitled to higher education at the expense of budget allocations in accordance with international treaties of the Russian Federation, federal laws or the quota established by the Government of the Russian Federation for the education of foreign citizens and stateless persons (hereinafter - the quota for education of foreign citizens), as well as at the expense of individuals and legal entities in accordance with agreements on the provision of paid educational services.

Admission to training within the quota for the education of foreign citizens is carried out in accordance with the directions of the federal executive authority government policy and regulation education. Admission to training within the quota for the education of foreign citizens is carried out by a separate order (orders) of the University.

Foreign citizens and stateless persons who are compatriots living abroad are entitled to higher education on an equal basis with citizens of the Russian Federation under provided that they comply with the requirements provided for in Article 17 of the Federal Law of May 24, 1999 No. 99 "On State Policy Of the Russian Federation in relation to compatriots abroad" (hereinafter - Federal Law No. 99).

For compatriots living abroad and not being citizens of the Russian Federation, special rights do not apply for admission to study under the specialty programs provided in in accordance with Federal Law No. 273, unless otherwise provided by an international treaty of the Russian Federation.

Upon admission of foreign citizens and stateless persons to study under specialty programs for places under contracts for the provision of paid educational services, the University established three general entrance examinations in the following subjects:

chemistry;

biology;

Russian language.

When accepting foreign citizens and stateless persons for training on specialty programs in English for places under agreements on the provision of paid educational services, the University has established two general entrance examinations in the following subjects:

chemistry;

biology.

When submitting documents for admission to study, a foreign citizen or a stateless person shall indicate in the application for admission details of an identity document or an identity document of a foreign citizen in the Russian Federation or

the identity of a stateless person in the Russian Federation in accordance with Article 10 of the Federal Law of July 25, 2002 No. 115 On Legal the situation of foreign citizens in the Russian Federation "(hereinafter referred to as the identity document of a foreign citizen), and represents in accordance with subparagraph 1 of paragraph 58 of the Admission Rules, the original or a copy of an identity document, citizenship, or a document, identity card of a foreign citizen.

Upon admission to training in accordance with Article 17 of Federal Law No. 99, a compatriot shall submit, in addition to the documents specified in paragraph 58 of the Rules, originals or copies of documents, stipulated by Article 17 of Federal Law No. 99

Foreign citizens who enroll in studies on the basis of international treaties present, in addition to the documents specified in paragraph 58 of the Rules, documents confirming their classification as the number of persons specified in the relevant international treaties.

When applying for training of foreign citizens and stateless persons in places under contracts for the provision of paid educational services

The university has set the following deadlines:

- 1) the deadline for accepting documents required for admission June 20;
- 2) the deadline for the receipt of documents required for admission from persons entering the training in Russian, and passing University entrance examinations 10 July;
- 3) the deadline for accepting documents required for admission, completion of entrance examinations and admission of persons entering to study in English, October 30.
